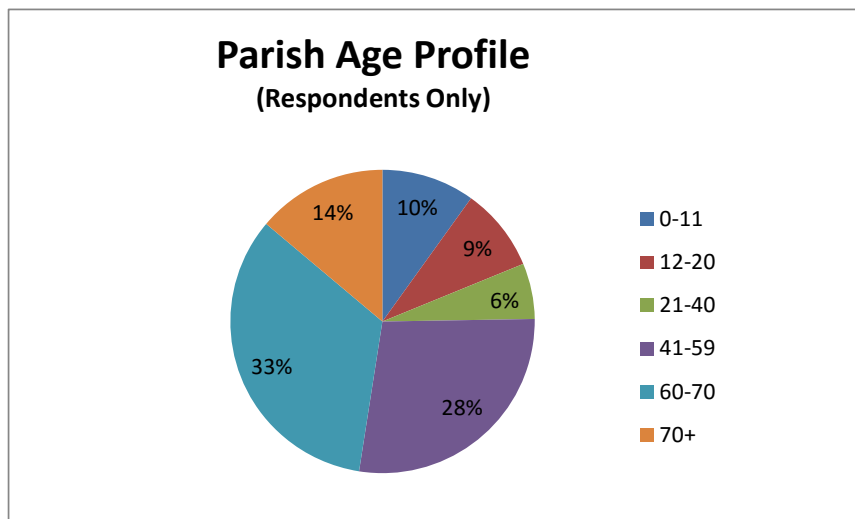


**ALLERTHORPE PARISH**

**QUESTIONNAIRE RESPONSE**

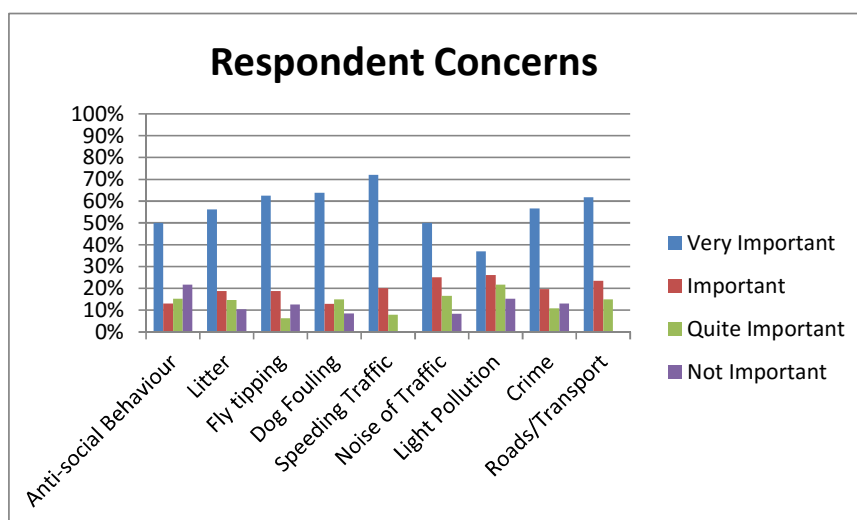
The Allertorpe Parish neighbourhood development plan consultation questionnaire was distributed throughout the parish in March 2016. 100 residential questionnaires were sent out and 50% were returned compared to 35% of the business questionnaires (7 returned from 20).

A summary of responses is summarised below.



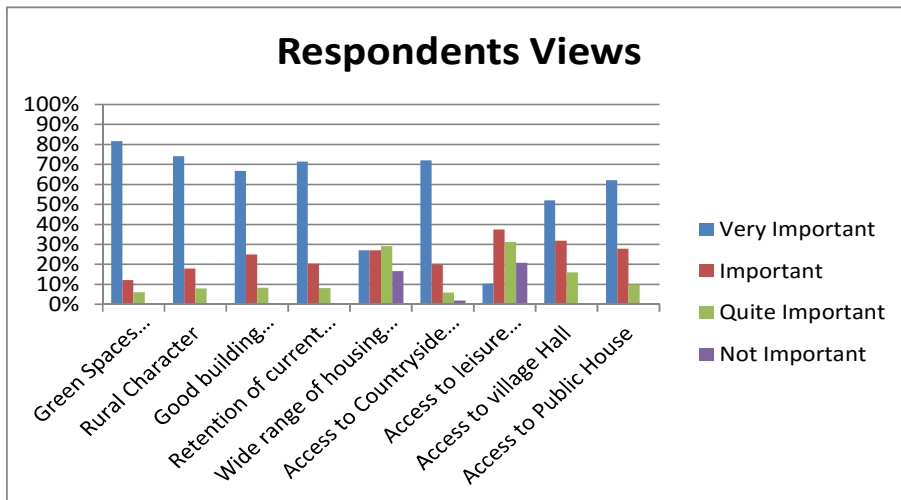
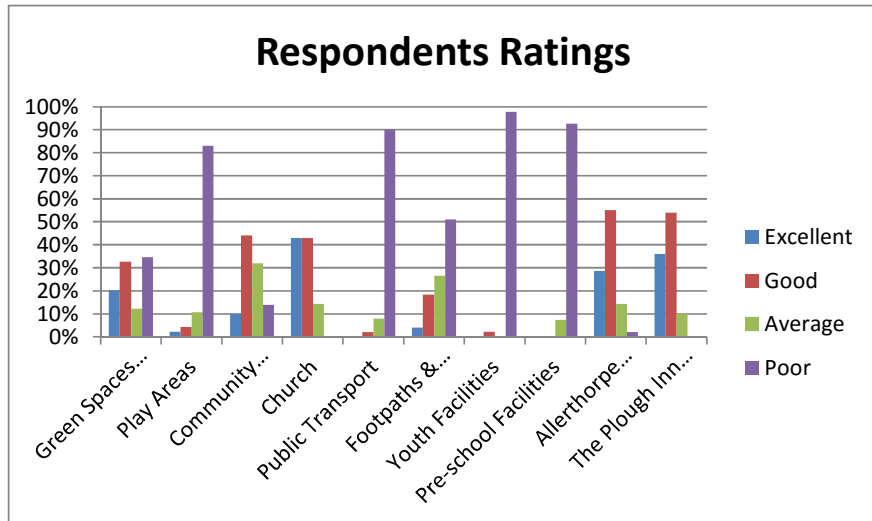
**Village Facilities**

“This is a beautiful English village that should be protected. People choose to live here for seclusion and peace and accept restricted services given the location.”

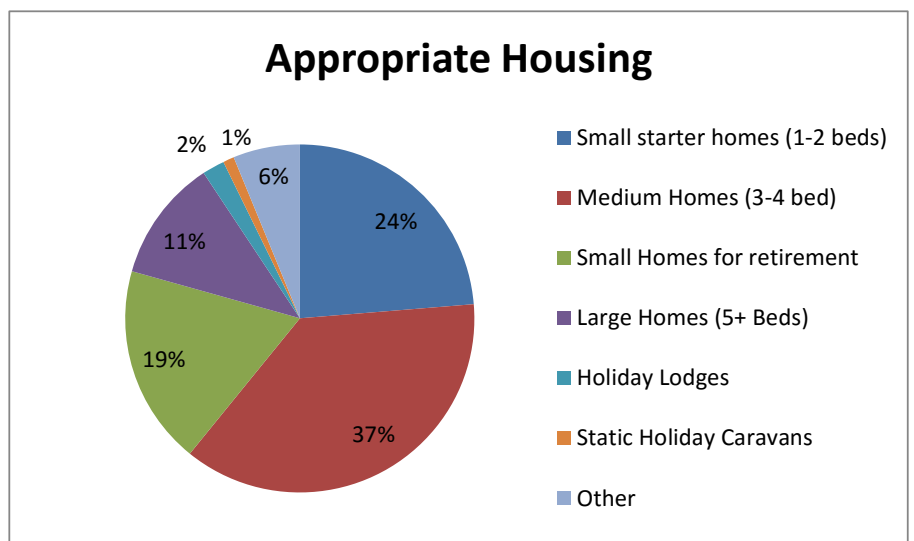
“Lack of facilities for younger people. Footpaths need improving especially from village past Golf Course to Lakeland Park”

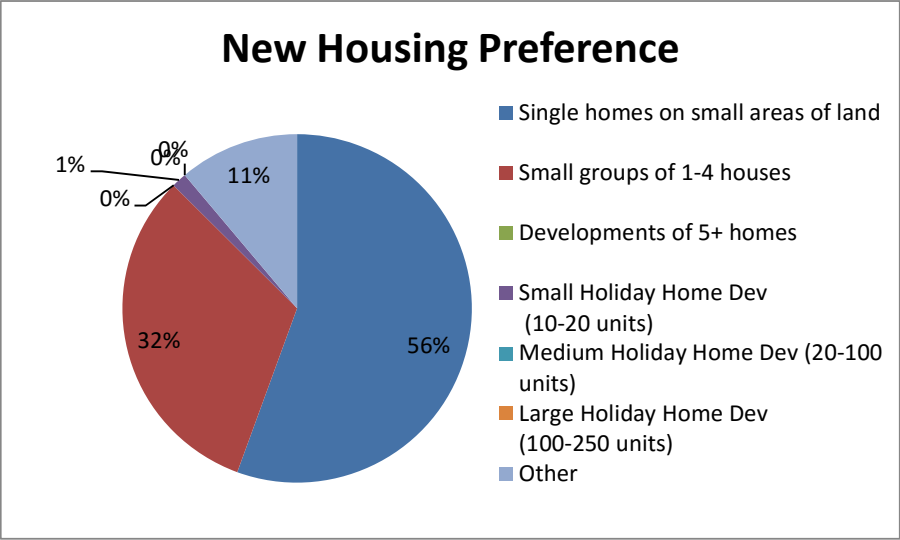


“No visible improvements over the years”
