Allerthorpe Parish Council's Emergency Planning Team are conscious that in the event of a widespread emergency, it could be up to 72 hours before outside assistance can be relied upon to support the needs of everyone in the Parish.

We are therefore making contingency plans to sustain everyone's needs for that period and are particularly focusing our efforts on our neighbours who may have specific medical needs or may be reliant on utilities for medical treatments.
