
Designation of Allerthorpe Neighbourhood Area

Allerthorpe Parish Council is preparing a Neighbourhood Plan to set out a vision and planning policies for the use and development of land in Allerthorpe Parish.

In June 2013 the Parish Council requested Allerthorpe Parish be designated as a Neighbourhood Area. This is the first stage in the preparation of a Neighbourhood Plan.

A 6 week consultation was held between 2 September - 18 October 2013 on the proposed area. The majority of respondents were supportive of designating Allerthorpe Parish as a Neighbourhood Area.

East Riding of Yorkshire Council has now approved the designation of Allerthorpe Neighbourhood Area.

The next stage is for the Parish Council to prepare the Neighbourhood Plan. This work has already started and will involve consultation with residents and stakeholders.

The Plan must then pass an independent examination and receive the support of more than half of those voting at a referendum before it can be adopted by East Riding of Yorkshire Council.

Adopted Neighbourhood Plans will form part of the development plan used by East Riding of Yorkshire Council to make decisions on planning applications.
