**Parish Council Meeting:** The next meetings of the Parish Council will be on 25<sup>th</sup> March 2015 and 20<sup>th</sup> May 2015 at 8:00pm.

*Members of the Public & Press are welcome at meetings of Allerthorpe Parish Council. Public Participation will commence prior to the start of the full council meeting when members of the public can raise questions or make statements to the Parish Council about any issues they may have. Because we are restricted to only 10 minutes, the public are encouraged to use this facility as an opportunity to raise issues rather than to seek resolution and in most cases the council will need to make referrals before being able to provide researched answers.*

**Footpath:** We were fortunate to have the Community Payback Team visit us before Christmas. They edged out the footpath from the village to the A1079 and although it has exposed just how poor the surface is, it now enables our young mums & dads to push buggies along a reasonably even and wide path.

**Free e-Magazines for Library users:** The East Riding library service is making it possible for library members to have free access to over 50 popular magazine titles. Whatever your hobby or interest, you can enjoy a full-colour interactive version of the latest editions, downloaded to any computer, tablet or smartphone. Once downloaded, you can read the magazines offline.
