**Parish Council Meeting:** The next meetings of the Parish Council will be on Monday 27<sup>th</sup> July and 28<sup>th</sup> September 2015 at 8:00pm..

Public Participation will commence prior to the start of the full council meeting when members of the public can raise questions or make statements to the Parish Council about any issues they may have. Because we are restricted to only 10 minutes, the public are encouraged to use this facility as an opportunity to raise issues rather than to seek resolution and in most cases the council will need to make referrals before being able to provide researched answers.*
